DEVELOPING THE MASTERING MY FUTURE PROGRAMME 2023 - 2026

We are asking WPA members to contribute between £5,000 and £15,000 and collectively collaborate to raise a minimum of £50,000 annually to enable us to create a property focussed specialism in the Mastering My Future programme for three years.

This total contribution will enable further delivery of the Mastering My Future programme for young people from underrepresented and deprived socio-economic backgrounds in Westminster.

Mastering My Future will introduce the property sector to young people across our borough, through working with teacher networks and attending school assemblies, and building on that through introducing the breadth of opportunities in the property sector in Westminster with our workshops.

Investment and partnership around Mastering My Future would support the WPA in its 2023 Business Plan commitments to engage with Westminster's hard-to-reach communities and young people, provide access to opportunities and information on Westminster's built environment and help local young people access jobs and other opportunities linked to our member's activities.
